



UMBRIA: LAND & LEGACY

Explore Narni, Perugia, Spello, Orvieto and Spoleto

Six-days itinerary through the wonders of Umbria region starting from the medieval town of Narni, continuing to the vibrant Perugia, the flower-lined streets of Spello, the spiritual aura of Assisi, the majestic Orvieto, Gubbio, Todi and lastly Spoleto, with a magnificent cathedral.

Day 1: Start of the tour - Narni

Upon arrival in Rome, our driver will greet you at the airport arrivals area and whisk you away to the charming town of Narni. En route, we'll enjoy a delicious lunch at a restaurant. Upon reaching **Narni**, we'll meet our guide for a captivating 2-hour exploration of this historic destination.

Our journey will start from **Narni's ancient underground**, followed by a leisurely stroll through the charming **Piazza dei Priori**. Admire the elegant medieval buildings and the majestic **Cathedral of San Giovendale**, explore the historic **Chiesa di Santa Maria Impensole** with our knowledgeable guide. Then, we'll transfer to a centrally located 4-star hotel in Perugia for dinner and overnight stay.



Day 3: Walking tour of Assisi

Breakfast at the hotel followed by a transfer to **Assisi**. With our english-speaking guide we'll explore this iconic pilgrimage site, tracing its rich history back to ancient Umbrian civilizations and Roman times.

We'll discover the architectural marvels of the **Basilica of Santa Chiara** and the **Papal Basilica of San Francesco** during a guided walking tour.

After lunch at a local restaurant, we'll head to **Santa Maria degli Angeli** to visit the **Basilica**, a testament to Franciscan heritage. Our guide will tell us its significance as a pilgrimage destination and the Indulgence of the Pardon established by St. Francis.

We'll conclude the day with a return to Perugia for dinner and overnight stay.



Day 2: Walking tour of Perugia and Spello

Breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a guided walking tour of **Perugia**, lasting 3 hours. Led by our expert guide, we'll explore the highlights of this charming city. We'll begin at **Piazza IV Novembre**, where you'll marvel at the stunning **Fontana Maggiore** and the original side facade of the 13th-century **cathedral of San Lorenzo**. We'll wander along the picturesque **Corso Vannucci**, known for its chocolate shops, until we reach the **Palazzo dei Priori**, home to the **National Gallery of Umbria**. The tour will culminate with a delicious lunch at a local restaurant.

Transfer to **Spello**, known as the "**city of flowers**," is renowned for its stunning flower arrangements crafted during Corpus Christi celebrations. We'll explore the charming streets of Spello and immerse ourselves in its vibrant floral culture. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight stay.



Day 4: Walking tour of Orvieto and Todi

Breakfast at the hotel before meeting our driver for a transfer to **Orvieto**. Perched on a tuff cliff, Orvieto boasts one of Italy's oldest Etruscan settlements.

With our guide we'll explore its charming alleys and uncover hidden gems while admiring breathtaking views. This guided tour will highlight the stunning **Cathedral of Orvieto**, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture adorned with vibrant artworks.

Afterwards, we'll savor a delightful lunch at a typical restaurant, then our tour will continue with a transfer to Todi.

Enclosed by medieval walls, **Todi** offers a picturesque setting with terraced landscapes. Accompanied by our guide, wander through the historic center, discovering hidden treasures like **Piazza del Popolo** and the **Palazzo del Capitano**. We'll marvel at the **Cathedral of Santissima Annunziata**, built atop a Roman temple, featuring a magnificent rose window and restored stained glass windows from the 19th century.

Return to the hotel for dinner and a restful overnight stay.



Day 5: Walking tour of Gubbio

Breakfast at the hotel before meeting our driver for a transfer to **Gubbio**. Known as the city of stone, Gubbio is steeped in history and charm. We'll explore its city center guided by our knowledgeable guide, visiting iconic landmarks such as **Piazza Grande**, **Palazzo dei Consoli**, and the **Cathedral**.

Marvel at the famous **Fontana del Bargello** and other renowned buildings.

After a lunch at a local restaurant we'll embark ourselves on a unique experience: taking the funicular from **Gubbio** to the **Basilica of Sant'Ubaldo**.

We'll admire breathtaking panoramas as we ascend the steep **Ingino Mountain**. We'll discover the basilica, housing the bronze urn containing the body of the patron saint Ubaldo, and soak in the atmosphere of the famous race of candles, celebrated annually in his honor.

Then, we'll transfer to the hotel for a dinner and an overnight stay.



Day 6: Spoleto - End of the tour

Breakfast at the hotel, check-out and meet the driver for a transfer to **Spoleto**, where ancient Roman remnants await. We'll marvel at the well-preserved pre-Roman dry-stone fortifications, a testament to the city's rich history. We'll explore the Roman temples, forum, and arches that still grace the city center, offering a glimpse into its past glory.

Next, we'll delve into the artistic wonders of the **Duomo**, where Renaissance masterpieces by Filippo Lippi and Pinturicchio adorn the walls. We'll admire Lippi's exquisite frescoes depicting Mary's life, complemented by a magnificent mosaic floor from the 12th to 13th centuries. We'll also discover the chapel adorned by Pinturicchio, adding further splendor to this architectural gem.

After a morning of exploration, we'll indulge in a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, savoring **Umbrian cuisine** and regional specialties.

Transfer to the airport three hours before your flight.
