Botticelli Thematic Tour

Discover the masterpieces of Botticelli with this thematic tour in Florence. You will visit the Uffizzi Gallery, Galleria dell'Accademia and Palazzo Medici Riccardi, the most important museum with the works of art of the Renaissance geniuis. You cannot miss the Florence walking tour in the footsteps of Botticelli

Day 1 - Start of the tour - Florence

- Arrival in Florence, transfer from the airport to 4* hotel in the city center
- **In the afternoon meeting with the guide for the visit of the city center on the paths of Botticelli**

The walking tour of the center of Florence will cover what are the classic squares and churches of the Tuscan capital, with particular attention to the Borgo Ognissanti, district where Botticelli was born and lived and where his house is located. In particular, we will visit the Chiesa Ognissanti, where Sandro Botticelli is buried

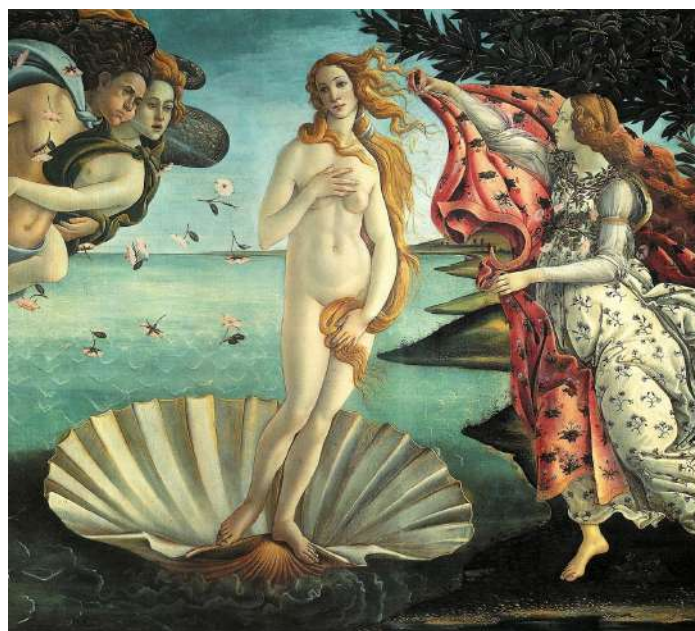


Day 2 - Florence

- Breakfast at the hotel and meeting with the guide in the lobby for the **visit of Galleria Uffizi**

You cannot stay in Florence without go to the Uffizi Museum, one of the most attractive rooms in the whole Uffizi Gallery is the **Botticelli room**, displaying two of the most admired and appreciated paintings of all times: **The Birth of Venus and The Primavera by Botticelli**.

Not only do these paintings witness the refined atmosphere of Florence in the period when they were painted (round 1482-1484), in addition to that, the delicate beauty of the main characters, especially Venus, have certainly become an icon of female beauty.



- **Afternoon tour: visit of Galleria dell'Accademia and Galleria Palatina in Palazzo Pitti**

Our Botticelli tour continues with the famous Galleria dell'Accademia, where masterpieces of Sandro Botticelli are collected, such as Madonna col Bambino Giovanni Battista e due angeli, Pala del Trebbio, all those paintings have returned to the museum after being "lent" abroad, now they are in the Hall of the Colossus of the Gallery.

We'll move to Palazzo Pitti and visit its Galleria Palatina. We will visit the majestic rooms of the Palazzo and one of the most famous paintings of a young Simonetta Vespucci, the muse of Botticelli, present in many of his paintings, including the famous Venus: Portrait of a lady, painted in 1485 ca.



The first Medici palace, the home of Cosimo the Elder and Lorenzo the Magnificent and the workplace of artists of the calibre of Donatello, Michelangelo, Paolo Uccello, Benozzo Gozzoli and Botticelli. The Renaissance house... where it all began.

Please, take note that the visit at Cappella dei Magi is allowed at 5 persons per time.

- > Afternoon free for individual visit

Day 4 - End of tour

- > Breakfast at the hotel
- > **Transfer to San Gimignano and guided tour of a winery with lunch and wine tasting**
