## History, Cars, and Cuisine

**Discover Emilia-Romagna's history starting from the heart of Bologna. Wander through the city to discover its medieval history and savor local delicacies. In Modena, visit the Ferrari Museum and Factory, explore the charming city center, and tour the Parmigiano Reggiano Factory for a complete cultural and culinary experience.**

### Day 1: Start of the tour

Arrival in Bologna Airport and transfer to Bologna city center. During the morning, walking tour of **Bologna city center** with a Polish-speaking guide. The morning tour ends at the enchanting **Piazza Santo Stefano**, with its picturesque complex of seven interconnected churches. Experience Bologna's rich history and vibrant culture at every step. Free time for lunch, transfer to the hotel. Accommodation in a 4\* hotel in the city center with 2 hours resting time. For dinner, tasting of the typical dishes of **Bolognese cuisine**. Return to the hotel for your overnight stay.



### Day 2: Maranello, Ferrari Museum and Factory

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to **Maranello** and visit of the **Ferrari Museum** and of the Ferrari Factory.

The visit offers a a thrilling glimpse into the world of Ferrari. Explore **historic racing cars**, interactive displays showcasing engineering marvels, and special exhibitions.

After the visit, the group will visit the **Ferrari Factory**.



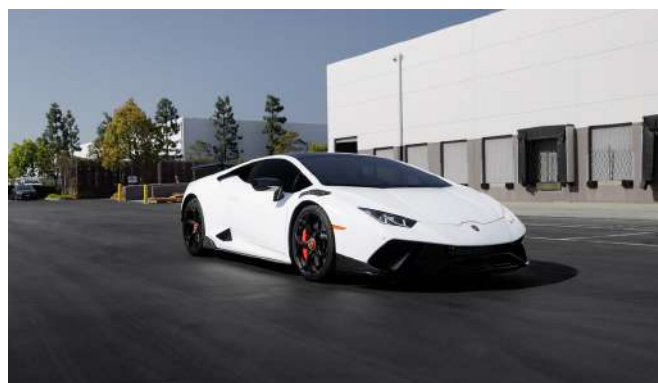
Transfer to **Acetaia G.Zoccoli** for a guided tour of balsamic vinegar with English speaking-guide (and Polish translator). Lunch is included.

During the afternoon, transfer to the **Lamborghini Museum** and guided tour with English speaking-guide (and Polish translator).

Embark on a thrilling tour of the Lamborghini Museum in **Sant'Agata Bolognese**, and discover the iconic history and engineering brilliance behind **Lamborghini's legendary cars** like the Miura, Countach, and Diablo.

Explore interactive exhibits showcasing cutting-edge technology and racing heritage.

Return to Bologna, overnight stay.





### Day 3: Tour of Parmigiano Reggiano Factory

Breakfast at the hotel. During the morning, transfer to **Modena** with a guided tour of **Parmigiano Reggiano Factory**.

This tour offers a fascinating dive into the world of **cheese-making** and visitors get to witness the entire process, from milk processing and curd cutting to molding the iconic wheels. The tour includes exploring aging rooms where cheese matures for 12 to 36 months. After the tour, **cheese tasting** is included. Later on, transfer to Modena and free lunch.

During the afternoon, transfer to **Modena city center** and walking tour. Explore Modena on foot to uncover its rich history and culinary delights.

Start at **Piazza Grande** with its **UNESCO-listed Modena Cathedral**, and **Ghirlandina Tower**. Wander through the Old Town's charming streets. This walking tour blends architectural splendor, cultural heritage, and gourmet experiences, offering a memorable taste of authentic Italian charm in Modena.

Return to Bologna for the overnight stay.



### Day 4: End of the tour

Breakfast at the hotel followed by transfer to the airport 3 hours before the flight.
