



THROUGH PIEMONTE'S FLAVORS TO LIGURIA'S SHORES

Exploring Art, Wine, and Breathtaking Landscapes

Set off on a 9-day journey through Piemonte and Liguria, exploring rich culture, scenic landscapes, and culinary delights. Explore Turin, savor fine wines in Langhe, and visit medieval gems like Aosta. Then, head to Liguria's stunning coast, from Genoa to Cinque Terre and Portofino, with guided tours and breathtaking views.

Day 1: Arrival in Turin

Arrive at Milan Linate Airport and transfer to **Turin** for check-in at a centrally located hotel. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided walking tour of Turin's elegant historic center, visiting **Piazza Castello**, the **Royal Palace**, **Palazzo Madama**, and the **Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist** (external visits only). Stroll through Via Roma and San Carlo Square, admire the Mole Antonelliana, and explore the lively Quadrilatero Romano. Conclude the day with dinner at a traditional restaurant before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 2: Alba and Langhe Wine Experience

In the morning, set off for a day in **Alba** and the **Langhe region**, famous for truffles and wine. Explore Alba's historic center, including Piazza Duomo and the **Cathedral of San Lorenzo**, and stroll along its charming main street. Continue to the **Barolo** area for a guided **wine tasting** with a **light lunch** at a local vineyard, enjoying stunning vineyard views. Return to Turin for dinner at a local restaurant and overnight stay.

Optional (not included): Olfactory Sensitive Experience is available for a deeper sensory journey.

Day 3: Bra, Pollenzo & Cherasco Discovery

After breakfast, embark on a full-day excursion to **Bra**, **Pollenzo**, and **Cherasco**. Begin in Bra, the heart of the Slow Food movement, offering stunning views of the Langhe. Continue to Pollenzo for a guided tasting at the **Wine Bank**, a UNESCO-listed institution preserving Italy's finest wines. In the afternoon, explore Cherasco, a charming town rich in medieval and Baroque architecture. Visit landmarks like **Arco del Belvedere**, the Town Hall, and the Church of San Pietro, and discover its famous chocolate and snail delicacies. Return to Turin for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 4: Castles and Roman Heritage in Aosta

Following breakfast, travel to **Castel di Fénis** for a guided tour of its medieval halls, frescoes, and fortified walls. Continue to **Aosta** for a guided exploration of its rich Roman and medieval heritage, including the **Arch of Augustus** and the **Roman Theater**. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping in this charming Alpine town. In the late afternoon, return to Turin for dinner at a local restaurant and an overnight stay.

Day 5: Genoa's Historic Heart

After breakfast, check out and transfer to **Genoa**. Upon arrival, check in at a centrally located hotel and enjoy free time for lunch. In the afternoon, take a guided tour of Genoa's historic center, exploring the **Porto Antico**, narrow caruggi alleys, Piazza De Ferrari, **Palazzo Ducale**, and the UNESCO-listed **Via Garibaldi** with its Palazzi dei Rolli. Spend the evening at leisure, discovering Genoa's vibrant nightlife around Piazza delle Erbe. Conclude the day with dinner at a traditional restaurant along the port before an overnight stay.



Day 6: Cinque Terre

Set off for a full-day excursion to **Cinque Terre** with the guide. Travel by Cinque Terre Express train, allowing easy access to the picturesque villages of **Monterosso**, **Vernazza**, **Manarola**, and **Riomaggiore**. Discover Monterosso's historic old town, Vernazza's charming harbor, Manarola's colorful cliffside houses, and Riomaggiore's fishing heritage. Stroll along the scenic Via dell'Amore before returning to Levanto by train. Transfer back to Genoa for dinner at a local restaurant and an overnight stay.



Day 7: Coastal Elegance

After breakfast, transfer to **Santa Margherita Ligure** for a full-day excursion with the guide. Explore its elegant streets, admire the marina, and visit the **Basilica di Santa Margherita d'Antiochia**. Take a ferry to the glamorous Portofino and discover its charming Piazzetta, scenic marina, Chiesa di San Giorgio, and **Castello Brown**, offering stunning sea views. Return to Santa Margherita Ligure by ferry, then transfer back to Genoa for dinner at a local restaurant and an overnight stay.



Day 8: Leisure in Genoa

Enjoy a **free day in Genoa** to explore at your own pace. Spend time shopping, visiting museums such as the Palazzi dei Rolli, or simply relaxing along the scenic seafront. In the evening, savor a special farewell dinner at a high-end restaurant before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 9: Departure

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Milan Linate Airport. End of services.
